The McDonald County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner, Larry Jones, & Western Commissioner, Ronald G. Walker present, & Eastern Commissioner, Sam Gaskill absent.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission conducted General Business of the County.

Commission discussed recent correspondence from Missouri Association of Counties concerning the state reimbursement for per-deim for inmates. Commissioner Jones had come in to the office on Friday to make calls to the Representatives that will make the decision whether to maintain the \$22. or reduce it to \$19. Commissioner Jones encouraged them to hold fast to the higher per-deim.

Commissioner Walker was also encouraging in trying to keep the higher per-diem & will also make contacts since that reduction would cause a large gap in reimbursement of county funds.

Commissioners Walker & Jones attempted again to clarify the progress on cleaning up the septic issue on Candy Lane. Commissioner Walker has been in contact with the property owner whose property has been damaged by the inadequate septic system at the trailer park next door. The Commission met with Chris Deem who is the County Environmental Specialist at the County Health Department. He has forwarded the needed paperwork to the Prosecuting Attorney & will continue to monitor progress.

Commission met with Rick Delk & Chuck Kirby from Finley Engineering to discuss the placement of telephone guide lines along county roads.

Commissioner Walker inspected several areas of concern at the jail & Sheriff's Department where leaks have occurred & will attempt to get someone to give an estimate on repairs.

Randy Grohler, resident on Oscar Talley Road requested permission to work on a water line that crosses the county road. Commission agreed to the repair.
