The McDonald County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner, Larry Jones, Eastern Commissioner, Sam Gaskill & Western Commissioner, Ronald G. Walker present.

APPROVE BILLS AND SIGN CHECKS

Commission approved bills and signed checks in the amount of \$52,774.36, total for all funds.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission conducted General Business of the County.

Commission received word that the Prosecuting Attorney has sent a 10 day warning letter to the property owner of Candy Lane Trailer Park concerning the failing septic system. Commission will review the progress of the issue next week.

County Clerk Williams requested permission from the Commission to ask the Master Gardeners plant a pine tree in place of the tree that died on the square in front of the Old Courthouse. The tree will be paid for by Mr. & Mrs. Williams, in memory of their son-in-law, Vernon Cook, who was killed by a drunk driver. Commission approved the planting & John Hobbs of the Master Gardener Program agreed to shop for & see to the planting of the tree. Mrs. Williams is the Director of the McDonald County Mother's Ageist Drunk Driving Organization.

Ronnie Rogers met with the Commission for clarification on several issues & said he appreciated the county road crews for their attempt to maintain the county roads in spite of the difficult times.

Callie Hudson & Bob Hudson met with the Commission to discuss the possibility of a grant that would replace the Eighth street bridge.

Commission adjourned to meet with some property owners in the Gordon Hollow area.
