The McDonald County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner, Larry Jones, Eastern Commissioner, Sam Gaskill & Western Commissioner, Ronald G. Walker present.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission conducted General Business of the County.

John Hobbs, Extension Officer & Lynn Jenkins, District Supervisor of NRCS (Natural Resources Conservation Service) met with the Commission to discuss the possibility of opening a Soil & Water Conservation office here in McDonald County that would assist residents with local concerns & make their services more available. Commission agreed to provide office space at no charge to the state & Mr. Jenkins & Mr. Hobbs agreed to research & see if it is a local office is a possibility at no charge to the county.

Mr. Jenkins also requested that the Commission adopt a Proclamation that recognizes the anniversary date of the agency in 1935 & proclaim April 27th, as Natural Resources Conservation Day, in McDonald County, Missouri.

Commissioner moved to adopt the proclamation with Commissioner Walker seconding & the vote was unanimous. Jones, yes; Gaskill, yes; Walker, yes.

Commission & County Road Foreman, Jerry Mullins, reviewed the tire bids that were received during Mr. Mullins absence. The bids were accepted from various bidders.

Commission reviewed the Duncan Lane issue & are working on possible solutions.
