### GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission met with Spencer Jones of Great River Engineering & Julie Ziebert, MODOT to discuss the financing of the Powell Bridge. Both entities will continue to research & will get back to the Commission to clarify the county's financial input.

Commission met with Custodian Dwayne Largent to discuss the recent complaints from the Sheriff on the toilet breakdowns. Mr. Largent stated he had gone to check as requested & that instead of 4 toilets not working, there was one that needs repair. Commission will continue to research replacement options & is planning on budgeting next year for some new plumbing in the jail.

Commission received two bids for striping of roads. Richard Sult bid 15 cents per linear foot & Time Striping big 12 cents per linear foot. After discussion, Commissioner Walker made the motion to accept the bid from Time Striping to stripe Mustang, Salt & Blecha Roads. Keith Lindquist seconded & vote was unanimous. Several compliments calls of appreciation were received for the county work done on these roads.

Deputy Chris Allison met with the Commission to request approval & a signature on a contract received for a grant that will purchase 7 body work cameras to be used by County Officers. Commission reviewed the grant & readily approved the grant & stated they are for anything that will improve the safety of our officers. It is a cash grant for \$5,836. The cameras will cost \$5,745.

Commission, County Clerk Williams & Treasurer Helm toured the Old Log Courthouse to see what renovations could be done to be able to partially open it to the public during special activity days. Commission agreed to try to find volunteer workers & see what can be done.
