GENERAL BUSINESS

After much discussion & several calls of concern Commissioner Walker made the motion & Commissioner Lindquist seconding to set a burn ban for the county under emergency circumstances.

Vote was unanimous, Lindquist, yes, Gaskill, yes, Walker, yes.

Commission were contacted concerning a water leak at the Jail. Commission contacted a local repairman to get the leak stopped & fixed. Also at that time they ordered an addition to the Floodplain office of a handicap ramp in order to make the office handicap accessible.

Commissioner Gaskill made the motion to pay MODOT the amount requested in order to continue the Powell Bridge project. After discussion Commissioner Lindquist tabled the motion until more information was received & clarification on how much was required on the project. The motion will then be picked up & voted on to be able to continue the project as soon as possible.

Commissioner Lindquist reported on the three meetings he had attended on Tuesday the 26th.

1. Newton McDonald Landfill
2. Simmons environmental update on water treatment
3. Southwest Regional Extension Council meeting that was held in Mt. Vernon & all 3 Commissioners attended

Sheriff Evenson brought paperwork to the Commission to complete work on the Deputy Salary Supplement grant. This grant will allow supplement of the salary of any deputy that makes less than \$28,000 up to that amount for the year of the grant. The total amount awarded is to be \$88,004.67.

Commissioners called several vendors that can supply rebar for construction for Mill Creek Bridge for price comparisons.


