GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission met with Sheriff Hall after his research on the inmate phone service issue. In comparing the two bids Commission agreed that the CTC Co Inc. was a much better deal for the county. Commissioner Keith Lindquist made the motion to go with the CTC Co Inc. & Commissioner David Holloway seconded with the vote unanimous.

Also discussed was the Restitution Board appointments that are required by Presiding Commissioner Lindquist. After discussion, Commissioner Lindquist appointed Commissioners Bunch & Holloway to the Board. Commissioners agreed to the appointment.

After discussion of need Commissioner Bunch made the motion to place in for repair the Ford dump truck. Commissioners Lindquist & Holloway agreed.

Commission met with MODOT Representative Supervisors Richard Arnall, Mike Smith & Tim Bundgard.

Plans for future projects were discussed. These Supervisors share the responsibility of different areas of maintenance of roads, bridges & rights of way in McDonald County. They will be planning on quarterly meetings for an exchange of information in the future.

Commissioner Lindquist opened the Pre Construction meeting at 10:00 & then turned the meeting over to Spencer Jones of Great River Eng. The Powell Bridge project was the topic of conversation & information. 6 representatives of the Powel Historical Preservation Society were present along with representatives from Great River Eng. & Lehman Construction.

Open discussion was held with a planned date of a ground breaking as early as mid-June. All present were pleased to hear that the project is still moving forward & funding is prepared. Meeting ^{ended} was closed at 12:00 noon.

Commission reconvened General Session after lunch.

County Clerk Williams informed the Commission that at this time all County Ordinances are on the county website except for one. That is the Floodplain Ordinance & is too lengthy, so an ordinance title & number is there with the suggestion to contact the County Clerk's office to see full Ordinance.


Mr. & Mrs. Ed Misner met with the Commission to get to know their Commissioner & at the same time request maintenance on White Oak Rd.
