GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission approved & signed checks in the amount of \$374,959.52 total for all funds including payroll.

Commission met with Paige Behm, Health Department Administrator, to discuss several issues including budget items funded by state & federal grants.

Jerry Mullins, County Road Foreman & Commissioner Holloway went to the MODOT location in Anderson to look at some paving materials.

Mr. Aaron Sherman met with the Commission to discuss Trail Wood Road. Mr. Sherman has some flooding issues & has figured out how to fix the ongoing problem, but wanted the county to know his fix will cause more road problems. But since his fix is on his own property & Commission agreed that he has a right to make the adjustments. They also stated appreciation to Mr. Sherman for his willingness to fix the problem & to work with the county as much as possible.

Presiding Commissioner Lindquist contacted the local DNR Representative to inquire as to when they would be going forward with the documentation of the septic issues on Candy Lane. Ms. Graves stated she will get to the problem as soon as possible & report back to the state office & see what can be done.

Randy Bailey of Bailey Quarries met with the Commission to discuss possible road repairs.

Jason Black met with the Commission to discuss generator information.

Commission, County Clerk Williams & Deputy Clerk Cole received a conference call from the State Auditors. Auditors expressed appreciation for the work that has been done by the county to adhere to their recommendations.

Camille Graves, DNR Representative, met with the Commission to discuss Candy Lane.
