GENERAL BUSINESS

Bob Corcoran, County Flood Plain Administrator, met with the Commission to discuss Flood Plain issues.

Rick Jordan met with the Commission to request more no parking signs for Oscar Talley Rd by the low-water bridge. Commission agreed & will supply signs & Mr. Jordan will install. Sticker will be added making people aware of the penalties of damaging or removing county signs.

County Assessor, Laura Pope met with the Commission to discuss BOE plan & procedures.

Sheriff Hall met with Commission to discuss the need for new laundry equipment. Sheriff Hall is looking into purchasing commercial equipment since they do large amounts of laundry & at this time they are using a residential equipment that has broken down. Commission agreed on the need & the Sheriff will have in his budget the needed funds. Also discussed were replacement vehicles for the highest mileage cars. Commission is looking into some used vehicles with comparatively low miles.

After a complaint discussion & research it was found that Liberty Rd in Southwest City is the cities responsibility & not under county maintenance.


Several calls from a property owner required research to find that the county has in the past maintained a portion of Honeymoon Hollow Rd that is on private property.

The county agreed to discontinue maintenance on that portion.
