GENERAL BUSINESS

Commission met with Sheriff Hall & Chief Deputy Roark to discuss several issues including the purchase of three used vehicles from Newton County Law Enforcement at the cost of \$7,200 for all three cars which was paid entirely from the Sheriff's Extradition & Transportation budget.

Sheriff Hall also reported that his office has answered 2,000 calls for service & 33 more book-ins at the jail than last year at this time.

Arlene Richmond met with the Commission to request maintenance on Blue Clay Ridge Rd.

Commissioner Lindquist opened the Board Of Equalization at 10 a.m. Present were all three Commissioner & County Clerk Williams along with Alberta Anders as a Board member.

With no appointments the BOE was extended to Wednesday the 17th.

Prosecuting Attorney Jonathan Pierce met with the Commission to discuss the Domestic Utility Tax that he had researched.

Commission went to an informational lunch with a Constituent Services Group from Senator Billy Long's office.

Commission met with Lisa McCool-Rataczak, Richard Huston & P.A. Jonathan Pierce.

They were joined by 911 attorney, Bob Evenson. The discussion was the results of Mr. Pierce's research which found that 911 does not qualify to receive the Domestic Use Tax.

Several road issues were also discussed.

Commission adjourned to go & inspect the new Sheriff's Dept. vehicles.
