General Business

Commission received & forwarded the pass through amount of \$50, 400. from MODOT to the Powell Historical Preservation Society. This completes the county involvement in the transaction that allows MODOT to transfer funds that would have been used to demolish the bridge to the PHPS for their use in maintenance & preservation of the 100 year bridge. Commission commends both MODOT & the PHPS for the diligence in getting the bridge preserved, and reminds the public that no county funds were used in this endeavor or the new replacement bridge.

Jerry Mullins, County Road Foreman, met with the Commission to discuss road & bridge maintenance & the 2015 budget.

Commission reviewed new bills from Prosecuting Attorney, Jonathan Pierce, for new office furniture. After discussion Commission approved the purchase under protest, since the items had already been shipped when the bill was received. The protest was due to the high cost of the furniture (1 table \$899. 6 chairs \$828.; 3 key cards-\$260) & the short time left in Mr. Pierce's time in office, but agreed that the funds were available in the Administrative Handling Fund which is under the Prosecuting Attorney's discretion.
