An agreement between McDonald County and 911 will be drawn up regarding the County's use of the current 911 signs to affix the different colored placards.

Billy and Brenda Brown talked to the Commission about the possibility of renaming the road they live on due to the fact there has been some confusion in the past with a similarly named road in the county. Mr. Brown also discussed the new road grader signs.
