




The Commission met with Rick Jordan regarding the Oscar Talley Bridge at Lanagan.

The Commission met with Steve Geeding regarding Duncan Drive. In attendance were Thurston Thompson, Nancy Wolfe (both with Mr. Geeding), Bill Dobbs (McDonald County Prosecuting Attorney), and Stephanie Blackmon (resident on Duncan Drive). Mr. Geeding stated that Billy Brown, resident on Duncan Drive, had the right to place a gate across the road, currently listed as a county road. Mrs. Blackmon replied the gate has caused an undue hardship in accessing her residence, located past the gate put in place by Mr. Brown. She also stated a mail receptacle with her address on the box had been placed at another location on the road without her consent. Mr. Geeding and the Commission had a copy of a deed dated June 14, 1973 giving McDonald County access to maintain a road on that land. Prosecuting Attorney Dobbs requested Mr. Brown keep the gate open, until such time an agreement or decision could be made, to allow the Blackmon family access to their residence, as well as allow Mr. and Mrs. Blackmon to have their mail delivered to the mail receptacle on their own property as it has been since 2006. Mr. Geeding agreed to these requests. Mr. Geeding requested documentation from 1973 regarding petitions and minutes that pertain to Duncan Drive. The County Clerk's office has paper copies of Commission minutes back to 1985. Minutes before 1985 are on microfiche at the state level. The County Clerk stated every effort will be made to obtain the requested information in a timely matter.
