General Business

The Commission met with MoDOT representatives; Steve Sheldon, Laurel McKean and Jason Stewart, to discuss future plans for the Larry Neff and Hwy 71 intersection. Also in attendance were Representative Bill Lant and McDonald County Prosecuting Attorney, Bill Dobbs. All were in agreement an Impact Study, as well as, discussions with the property owners on the West side of the intersection were necessary. Jeff Simpson, land owner of one said property, met with the Commission later in the day. The Commission discussed the flood plain and intersection with Mr. Simpson and he was going to do some more research.

Representatives from Great River Engineering, Jeff Banderet and Jerany Jackson, met with the Commission to discuss the Oscar Talley Bridge project. Also in attendance were Dick and Bev Snyder and Robert E. Jordan, property owners. The Commission heard points from the property owners and the representatives. An agreement was made for temporary construction and a perpetual easement.


Jeff Meadows, Larson Farm & Lawn Supply, brought the Commission paperwork for the purchase of a tractor for the Road and Bridge Department.
