James Richards, Avion Bryant, and Jason Rincher - Stronghold Data, met with the Commission for a business review. Also in attendance were: Treasurer Sheila Fuller, Assessor Sue Ann Stokes, and Public Administrator Tonya Garvin. James Richards, CEO of Stronghold, asked those in attendance if there were any concerns or needs. Public Admin needs remote work station capabilities to effectively run her office.


Mr. Richards stated they could have remote capabilities completed within the week. Treasurer has issues every time an update is needed for accounting software, which is often, and she has to call the Service department each time. Mr. Richards said admin rights could be given to the Treasurer. Assessor has not been able to fully integrate to the cloud because of a software company's incompatibility to Stronghold Data cloud services. Stronghold is working with the company to rectify the issue. Mr. Rincher told the group Cyber Security standards are increasing across the country and State standards on cyber security is changing. Missouri Association of Counties is trying to work with the state to get cyber security funding for Missouri Counties. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) can also be used to cover IT costs.
