General Business

Brandon Mayhue met with the Commission to discuss Colony Road in Benton County Arkansas that turns into Deer Creek on the McDonald County side. Mr. Mayhue stated over the past several years the amount of vandalism, theft, destruction, harassment, and questionable activities on his dad's property have increased drastically. He is requesting Benton County close Colony Road to the public due to the many problems the family has had to deal with over the years. Commission told Mr. Mayhue they had originally wrote a letter of support in keeping Colony Road open to ensure McDonald County citizens had an emergency egress due to dangerous flooding or other natural disasters. Mr. Mayhue state he would ensure the McDonald County residents would have emergency access through if needed. He also stated Emergency Services would also have access to the gate anytime access was needed. McDonald County Commission stated it was not an issue on the county's side and would send a letter to Benton County stating they are in support of Colony Road being closed to public.

County Treasurer Sheila Fuller informed the Commission three (3) Certificates of Deposit were about to come up for renewal. Discussion whether to rollover or close the CDs ensued. Commissioner Lant made a motion to issue a court order to Sheila Fuller to rollover all three CDs into six month CDs as listed below:

County Revenue CD - \$502,906.19

Health Department CD - \$130,755.60

Law Enforcement CD - \$352,034.33

Seconded by Commissioner Cope. Motion passed with unanimous vote.


