General Business

Commission reviewed calls from the weekend. With Wednesdays bid opening coming up they reached out to some contractors again as no bids have been received for the Dead End Lane.

1:00pm Commission met with a group that is concerned on more oversight on organized cycling events that occur in our Rural parts of McDonald County. Those present are listed below:

Key Topics Discussed:
Overtime pay for staff
Event safety and enforcement
Cycling event planning and permitting

1. Pay & Staffing

Staff working cycling events may earn \$50–\$75/hour, with a 4-hour minimum.

Extra fees may be added for fuel and maintenance.

Travel time compensation and staff availability were noted as concerns.

2. Safety & Oversight

Safety enforcement discussed, including rules on cyclist spacing and traffic laws.

Law enforcement presence to be determined by the Commission and Sheriff, with a minimum of two officers per route review (pending ordinance changes).

3. Event Details

Estimated attendance: 1,200 participants.

Proper signage will be required to ensure public awareness and safety.

4. Permitting & Rules

Permit fees will help cover wages and road upkeep.
Cyclists must follow event rules; violations may result in fines.
Insurance coverage will be required for event organizers and staff.

5. Legal & Naming Updates

A name change from the current label to "Special Events" is proposed. Violation enforcement was referenced under Missouri law (Section 307.190).

6. Community Impact

Permits aim to support McDonald County through road maintenance and improvements. The initiative is part of a broader rural recreation and community engagement effort.

7. Event Date

The cycling event is scheduled for October 18.

Note: The ordinance and permit process are still under review and not finalized at this time.
