## McDonald County Commission—Minutes

December 17th, 2025

### General Business

Commission signed and approved accounts payable in the amount \$45,587.20.

County Treasurer Fuller met with the Commissioners to discuss the State of Missouri Disaster Relief funds. She received a breakdown from Emergency Management Director for proper distribution.

Presiding Commissioner Bryan Hall moved to authorize the transfer. Commissioner Cope second the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The McDonald County Commission hereby authorizes the County Treasurer, Sheila Fuller, to transfer revenues received from State of Missouri Disaster Relief PW# 00026/ PN #960131 from the Special Road and Bridge (C3) in the amount of

\$ 1774.29 back to the following Fire Districts:

Treasurer Fuller continued the meeting with an update, confirming that the 6-month CD renewal rate was also offered at a lower rate 3.85%. Commissioner Lett moved to roll over the following CDs with a 6-month maturity at the accepted rate of 3.85% CD #266200, #266053, #266050, #266048, and #266043.

Commissioner Cope seconded the motion. All were in favor, the motion carried.

After a thorough review of the current financial status, the Commission discussed the need to stabilize two departmental funds (Health & Law Enforcement) that have been operating at a deficit.

Commissioners emphasized the importance of maintaining a positive and healthy balance for these funds to ensure sustainability.

Eastern Commissioner Jamey Cope moved to equally distribute funds from the General County Revenue fund into Health and Law Enforcement as follows:

\$51,434.79 transferred to Law Enforcement

\$51,434.80 transferred to Health Department

Commissioner Lett second the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The Commission strongly encourages all budget managers to exercise fiscal responsibility and remain mindful of their expenditures in the upcoming budget year. The General County Revenue Fund serves as a budgetary assistance mechanism for funds that cannot sustain themselves through their own revenue streams alone.
