

COUNTY ORDINANCE REGULATING
GLASS CONTAINERS ON RIVERS AND STREAMS

ORDINANCE NO. 99-101

BE IT ORAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF
MCDONALD, STATE OF MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

99-101. Definitions As used in sections 95 - 102. through 99-103 the following terms
mean:

- a.) "Glass Container", any of a large class of gen. transparent or translucent materials
that harden from the molten state without crystallizing and becoming true solids and used as a
receptacle for holding and carrying.
- b.) "Rivers and Streams", a relatively large natural stream of water, naming Elk
River, Indian Creek, Big Sugar, and Little Sugar.

99-102. Prohibitions

From and after the date of adoption of this section it shall be unlawful within the borders
of McDonald County to have in possession any glass container upon Rivers and Streams of Elk
River, Indian Creek, Big Sugar, and Little Sugar.

99-103 Penalties

- 1.) Violations of Section 99-102 is punishable by fine of up to one hundred dollars
(\$100.00), or a fine set by the court.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION THAT THIS
ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS DATE
OF PASSAGE.
