
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MCDONALD, STATE OF MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Missouri Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri allow for a creation of an "Inmate Security Fund," which shall be funded by a two dollar (\$2.00) surcharge that shall be assessed as costs in each criminal case, including violations of any county ordinance or any violation of criminal or traffic laws of the State of Missouri, including an infraction or violation of a municipal ordinance, filed in the Circuit Court or Associate Circuit Court of McDonald County, Missouri.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Commissioners of McDonald County, Missouri, as follows:

Pursuant to the authority granted by, and subject to, the provisions of Section 488.5026 RSMo, the Commissioners of McDonald County, Missouri, hereby approve the creation of the "Inmate Security Fund," which shall be funded by a two dollar (\$2.00) surcharge that shall be assessed as costs in each criminal case, including violations of any county ordinance or any violation of criminal or traffic laws of the State of Missouri, including an infraction or violation of a municipal ordinance, filed in the Circuit Court or Associate Circuit Court of McDonald County, Missouri, and all said surcharges shall be disbursed to the McDonald County Treasurer for deposit in the "Inmate Security Fund."
